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REGOLAMENTO GENERALE EXPOMEDICINA

Articolo 1

TITLE, DATE AND PLACE OF THE EXHIBITION - ORGANIZERS

Expomedicina, organized by Interproject S.r.l., will take place at the Fiera del Mediterraneo Montepellegrino in the city of Palermo from October 26th to 29th, 2025, and will be dedicated to public and private healthcare, providing a complete and qualified overview of the most innovative technologies, solutions, and products in the sector.

Article 2

VISITORS AND ENTRY REGULATIONS

Expomedicina is a professional conference that can be accessed by invitation from exhibitors or by paying an entrance ticket. The invitation, reserved for professional operators, allows entry to the event on a day of choice.

Article 3

DURATION, EVENT HOURS

The duration of the event is specified in the admission application. For the entire duration and throughout the opening hours of the event, the Exhibitor must ensure that the assigned stand is staffed. Interproject reserves the unquestionable right to change the times and date of the event.

Article 4

ADMISSION

The following are admitted to exhibit at Expomedicina:

- a) manufacturers and service providers whose activities fall within the product sectors of the attached classification;
- b) their authorized distributors and/or exclusive representatives for Italy or part of the national territory;
- c) consortia, sole proprietorships, companies, entities, and publishing houses whose activities fall within the product sectors of Expomedicina and with reference to goods, products, and services included therein.

Article 5

REPRESENTED, GUEST, AND ASSOCIATED COMPANIES

The subjects referred to in art. 4 may only exhibit in the assigned space goods of their own manufacture or products of:

- Companies exclusively represented: Exhibitors referred to in art. 4 let. b) must indicate the represented companies on the admission application. They must also demonstrate that they hold the quality of exclusive distributors for all or part of the national territory, attaching a declaration from the represented company itself, or a copy of the distribution contract valid for the current year. In the event of a dispute regarding entitlement to the qualification of exclusive distributor, the written declaration of the represented company shall be the sole authoritative source. Companies represented on a non-exclusive basis may be admitted as guest companies.
- Guest companies: all Exhibitors may request to host other companies within their stand, declaring them in the application and attaching written authorization from the same. Interproject reserves the right to evaluate from time to time the opportunity to accept this request, especially if the hosted company already participates in the exhibition as an Exhibitor or a represented company.
- Associated companies: in the case of collective participations (groups, consortia, associations, etc.) the parent company holding the ADMISSION APPLICATION can list the other companies by attaching documentation proving the status of parent company. Without the requested documentation, the represented guest and associated companies will not be included in the General Catalogue.

Article 6

REGISTRATION, DEPOSIT, AND DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING THE ADMISSION APPLICATION

The subjects referred to in the previous art. 4 must send this admission application to Expomedicina, to Interproject S.r.l. - Via Vitt. Em. Orlando, 8 - 95129 Catania, duly completed and signed with specific acceptance of the particular clauses mentioned in the postscript, no later than 45 days before the start of the event. The postal stamp or the date and receipt declaration by Interproject if delivered by hand will serve as proof of this. Applications received after this date will be considered subject to space availability. The application must be accompanied by:

- deposit of 40% as agreed;
- form for represented, guest or associated companies.
- for new Exhibitors only: illustrative documentation (catalogues, brochures, photos, etc.)
- where required, documentation as per art. 6;
- copy of the Chamber of Commerce registration certificate (max 6 months);
- technical sheet of the set-up and products they intend to exhibit.
- form for requesting exhibitor invitations.

Interproject reserves the right to make the admission of the applicant subject to examination of the documentation.

Applications that do not comply with the aforementioned requirements, as well as requests for additions or changes to the applications themselves, received after the aforementioned deadline, may not be accepted. Interproject has the right to proceed differently in particular cases, at its sole discretion, according to methods and conditions that will be identified from time to time. The admission applications to the event cannot contain any reservations or conditions whatsoever.

Article 7

ACCEPTANCE OF THE GENERAL REGULATIONS

By signing the admission application, the Exhibitor undertakes to participate in the event, in the space that will be assigned to him as per art. 11, and to accept without reservation the General Regulations, and all the supplementary provisions that will be issued, at any time, by the organizers in the interest of the event.

Article 8

ADMISSION CONFIRMATION AND PAYMENT TERMS

Acceptance of the admission application in accordance with articles 6 - 7 is exclusively reserved for the unquestionable and unappealable evaluation of Interproject, which will not be required to provide any justification. Acceptance of the application and admission to the event will be considered to have taken place either with written communication (notification) to the requesting company of the assignment of the space and admission to the event within 10 days of receiving the application. The notification will be sent to the Exhibitor and the delivery receipt retained by the courier or other equivalent documentation will be valid for the date. If, after admission, it is found that the Exhibitor does not possess the requirements of articles 4 - 6, Interproject reserves the right to exclude or expel him from the event. The exclusion and/or expulsion will be considered as a withdrawal of the application with the application of art. 10. The balance of the amounts due as a participation fee must be paid no later than 30 days before the event. This will entitle the exhibitor to an entry pass that must be shown to set up their stand. Failure to pay by the indicated deadlines will be considered as a waiver of participation in the event with consequent prohibition of setting up and application of the following art. 10.

Article 9

WITHDRAWAL

Withdrawal from participation in the event or withdrawal of the application must be communicated by registered letter with return receipt sent to Interproject S.r.l., via Vitt. Em. Orlando, 8 - 95129 Catania. In the event that the requesting company withdraws or withdraws the application before notification of the assignment of the space, the following will be retained: € 520.00 for expenses incurred by Interproject for processing the application if the withdrawal is received no later than 60 days before the start of the event; the entire deposit if the withdrawal is received 59 days before the start of the event. If the withdrawal is received after notification of the assignment of the space (notification), Interproject will have the right to demand payment of all fees and charges due and/or agreed. In any case, if the withdrawal of the application occurs after the 40th day from the start of the event, Interproject will still have the right to demand payment of the entire fee, even if the assignment of the space has not been notified. In no case may the company claim from Interproject reimbursement of expenses and charges incurred for the space and its equipment. These clauses will also apply in the case of partial withdrawal from the reserved space.

Article 10

ASSIGNMENT OF EXHIBITION SPACES

The assignment of the exhibition spaces, their size, their position and their location in the various areas are decided unquestioningly by Interproject. The preferences expressed by the Exhibitor in the admission application, which in any case will not bind Interproject in any way, will be taken into account considering the general interest of the event and the essential divisions by product sectors. Interproject also reserves the right to modify the location and/or size of the space already assigned, if this becomes necessary due to technical reasons or organizational needs. The Exhibitor waives any claim arising from any modification of the location and/or size of the assigned space due to technical reasons or organizational needs of Interproject.

Article 11

VARIOUS SERVICES

The services included in the membership fee and the registration fee are as follows:

- inclusion of data in the General Catalogue (see art. 13);
- supply of a free copy of the General Catalog;
- registration and inclusion of data in the Expomedicina.it service;
- sign indicating the stand number;
- exhibitor badges;
- assistance to Exhibitors;
- general surveillance of the pavilions;
- civil liability insurance (as better specified in art.18);

The following "essential mandatory services" are also included in the cost per square meter:

- electrical power installed up to 3 KW (installation including electrical panel, free for pre-fitted areas and at a cost of 100 euros + Iva 22% for bare areas);
- fire extinguishers (will be delivered under the Exhibitor's custody, who will be responsible in case of damage or theft);

The Exhibitor is responsible for paying copyright fees and for live musical performances (with singers and/or musical instruments) for which the Exhibitor must contact the SIAE offices in the city. The amount of the membership fee and the conditions for the different types of exhibition space are indicated on the admission application.

Article 12

INFORMATION ON THE GENERAL CATALOG AND THE EXPOMEDICINA.IT SERVICE

The publication of company details in the printed General Catalogue is guaranteed to all Exhibitors registered within the provided terms. After registration, the Exhibitor will provide Interproject with information relating to the products and company activity, in Italian and English, for inclusion in the online General Catalogue. This data must be sent no later than 15 days before the event, after which date publication in printed form is not guaranteed. Exhibitors are invited, in their own interest, to respect the indicated deadlines. Exhibitors undertake to verify the effectiveness of their communication and the accuracy of the data contained to prevent errors both on the web and in the printed version of the General Catalogue. Any corrections or modifications to be made can be made within 15 days of the event. Interproject reserves the right to charge the Exhibitor for the consequent expenses deriving from late corrections or modifications, it being understood that Interproject will be exempt from any liability deriving from the incorrect or imperfect reproduction in the General Catalogue of the Exhibitor's data if, due to this delay, the updating of the data itself has not been carried out in whole or in part.

Article 13

Within expomedicina.it there will be a section dedicated to Exhibitors, where it will be possible, where applicable, to enter their data. The Exhibitor Catalogue will remain online until the announcement of the next edition of Expomedicina. The expomedicina.it service is included in the registration fee. The fee relating to the Catalogue is included in the registration fee.

Article 14

LIABILITY FOR INFORMATION

The Exhibitor undertakes to keep confidential and not to disclose to third parties, nor to use directly or indirectly, for reasons not strictly related to the performance of the trade fair event, news and data relating to Interproject's customers, of which he becomes aware during the execution of the contract. The Exhibitor undertakes to observe the provisions of law 31.12.1996 n. 675 and subsequent amendments with reference to these personal data of third parties and acknowledges that any personal data transmitted to him, must be processed exclusively for the purpose of fulfilling the obligations contemplated by the contract and therefore cannot be processed by him for purposes other than the execution of the contract. The Exhibitor undertakes to adopt all the security measures necessary to prevent the aforementioned personal data from coming into the possession of unauthorized third parties, for any reason, undertaking to indemnify Interproject from any claim or damage deriving from the violation of this commitment. The Exhibitor declares and guarantees that the personal data contained in its advertising and promotional materials were obtained in compliance with law 31.12.1996 n. 675 and subsequent amendments and that any data controllers and/or parties concerned in these data have expressly consented to the processing and communication and/or dissemination implicit or consequential to the publication of these data, with Interproject being exempt from the obligation to request their consent to this processing from the data controllers. The Exhibitor assumes full responsibility for the basis of this declaration, releasing Interproject from any claim for damages deriving from the violation of the law n. 675 of 1996 relating to the processing of personal data contained in its advertising and promotional materials. The Exhibitor assumes full responsibility for the content of the information and texts sent, acknowledging that they are solely responsible for them and releasing them from any consequent claim for damages or recourse and reimbursing Interproject for any costs deriving from claims or actions by third parties based on the violation of intellectual property rights of third parties or on the commission of unfair competition carried out by the Exhibitor during their activity contemplated in this contract.

The Exhibitor acknowledges and recognizes that Interproject does not carry out any checks on the regular ownership of the intellectual property of the Exhibitors. The Exhibitor therefore waives from now any action or claims against Interproject if other Exhibitors act or exhibit in violation of the rights of the former.

Interproject is also not required to take any expulsion measures or anything else against the Exhibitors who act or exhibit in violation of the rights of other Exhibitors, except for any measures requested by the Judicial Authorities.

Article 15

PROHIBITIONS

In general, anything that could cause prejudice, disturbance or damage to the regular course of the event and its purposes is prohibited. In particular, it is prohibited to:

- a) assign or sublet the assigned space to third parties, even free of charge;
 - b) exhibit in the spaces products of companies that have not been declared in the admission application and officially accepted by Interproject, as well as exhibit or deal with products relating to sectors not specified in the admission application.
- Exemptions from this prohibition may exceptionally be allowed if justified by the need to exhibit or demonstrate a legitimately exhibited product, provided that they are requested in writing at least 30 days before opening;
- c) exhibit second-hand or reconditioned hardware and software products;
 - d) if not authorized, proceed with the sale with immediate delivery of goods or services, including editorial products;
 - e) take photographs and films or similar inside your stand and the pavilions if not equipped with specific authorization issued by Interproject, Commercial Management;
 - f) carry out sound presentations, attractions and/or any type of sound solicitation within the stands that exceeds the established acoustic limit or in any case that is such as to disturb other Exhibitors or Visitors.

The Exhibitor also undertakes to indemnify and hold Interproject harmless from any pretext deriving from the violation of the acoustic regulations, also undertaking to compensate Interproject for any sums that the latter may be ordered to pay or disbursed in transit, including legal costs;

- g) exhibit and use media (videocassettes, DVDs, CD, CDs, CDs, music cassettes, records, floppy disks, etc.) that do not comply with or violate the provisions of law 21/4/1941 n.633 (copyright law) and of the D.L. 685 of 16/11/1994 (implementation of Directives 92/100/EEC concerning the rental right, the lending right and certain rights related to copyright in the field of intellectual property) and subsequent variations and/or amendments;

The Exhibitor will therefore assume all responsibility for non-compliance with the aforementioned legislative provisions;

- h) carry out itinerant advertising and/or distribute promotional material in the aisles and avenues inside the fair area (art. 21);
- i) close the free sides of the assigned space with continuous walls for a length exceeding 75% of the length of the side (art.20);
- l) leave the stand unattended;
- m) remain in the stands or in the exhibition center during closing hours.

Violation of even one of the aforementioned prohibitions may result in the temporary closure of the stand or immediate exclusion or expulsion from the event in progress or non-admission to subsequent ones, at the unquestionable discretion of Interproject. The non-compliant Exhibitor cannot claim any compensation from Interproject, following the application of the sanctions, without prejudice to Interproject's right to compensation for any damages suffered.

Interproject must in any case be held harmless from any penalties that, as a consequence of such non-compliance, may be imposed by the judicial police bodies, by other supervisory bodies and in general by the Public Authority. Interproject reserves the right to proceed against those responsible to obtain compensation for any damages.

Article 16

OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY

The Exhibitor undertakes to observe and ensure that all those operating on its behalf observe the legislation in force regarding prevention and protection for safety and health in the workplace and in particular Legislative Decree n. 626 of 19/9/94 and subsequent additions and amendments, as well as what is established in the Technical Regulations. The Exhibitor will therefore be responsible for compliance with the legislation in force on the matter and undertakes to indemnify Interproject against any liability for any accidents suffered by the personnel used by it, as well as against any dispute that may be raised in this regard by the competent Authorities.

Article 17

INSURANCE

Interproject provides, in its own interest and for its own needs, a normal daytime and nighttime surveillance service, without thereby assuming any responsibility for any theft or damage to the goods exhibited in the stands or, in any case, located in the fair district. The value of said goods must be insured by each exhibitor, against all exhibition risks, not excluding those connected to the infiltration of rainwater. Therefore, Interproject declines any responsibility for any damage suffered by the exhibited goods. Interproject, as delegated by the exhibitors, directly provides civil liability insurance for damage caused to third parties, by things and people from the aforementioned exhibitors. This insurance does not exclude the exhibitor's liability for damages of a value exceeding the guarantee limits set at € 500,000.00.

Article 18

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Interproject reserves the right to establish, even in derogation from these regulations, rules and provisions that it deems appropriate to better regulate the event and the services pertaining to it. These rules and provisions will be communicated to the Exhibitors and will have equivalent value to these regulations and equal mandatory nature; therefore, in case of non-observance, the offender may be expelled and/or excluded from the event, with the obligation to compensate Interproject for the damages suffered.

Article 19

TECHNICAL STANDARDS

Furthermore, the exhibitor undertakes to return all mandatory forms duly signed to Interproject. The free sides of the assigned space cannot be closed with continuous walls for a length exceeding 75% of the length of the side. Any space beyond that assigned to the exhibitor and resulting from the contract, which is abusively occupied, will be evaluated and immediate payment will be required, based on the cost per square meter of the immediately adjacent stand.

Article 20

PROMOTIONAL-ADVERTISING ACTIONS AND PARTICULAR EVENTS

Advertising - excluding that within the stands of which they are the owners - may be carried out by the Exhibitors, in agreement with Interproject, which reserves the exclusive right to manage it.

It is forbidden to carry out itinerant advertising and to distribute promotional material in the aisles and avenues inside the Exhibition Center. Any presence of "testimonials" or the organization of other events that may lead to concentrations of public that exceed the normal conditions of use of the Exhibition Center must have adequate security measures that the Exhibitor must provide to adopt, with responsibility and costs at its exclusive charge.

Article 21**USE OF THE EXPOMEDICINA BRAND**

Exhibitors may use the event's brand in their communications and on printed materials, exclusively in the variations and with the lettering indicated by Interproject.

Article 22**INFORMATION PROVIDED TO THE INTERESTED PARTY AND DECLARATION OF CONSENT PURSUANT TO LAW N. 675/96**

The Exhibitor expresses their consent for Interproject to process their data, including electronically, for sending them informational, advertising, or promotional material. They express their consent to the communication of data to Exhibitors, suppliers, commercial partners of Interproject for advertising, promotional, and commercial actions and initiatives in general. They declare that they are informed that pursuant to art. 13 of law 675/96, at any time and free of charge, they may have access to their data, request its modification or deletion or oppose its use by writing to Interproject S.r.l. - Via V. Em. Orlando 8, 95129 Catania.

Article 23**FORCE MAJEURE**

In case of force majeure, and in any case for reasons beyond the control of Interproject, the date of the event may be changed or the event may even be canceled. In the latter case, Interproject, having fulfilled its obligations to third parties and covered the organizational expenses incurred, will return to the Exhibitors as reimbursement the remaining sum, in proportion and in any case within the limits of what the Exhibitor has paid up to that date. Interproject will in any case have the right to compensation for the expenses incurred for the construction of systems and/or installations carried out on specific orders from the Exhibitors. Interproject will not be responsible for damages, which cannot be claimed for any reason.

Article 24**COMPLAINTS AND EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION**

Any complaints must be presented in writing to Interproject. For any dispute, the judicial authority of the Court of Catania will have exclusive jurisdiction, with the exclusion of any other possibly concurrent jurisdiction.

Article 25**TOLERANCE**

Interproject reserves the right to take action to enforce the terms and conditions of these General Regulations. Any tolerance of behaviors in violation of the Regulations cannot constitute acquiescence or a waiver of asserting all claims deriving from the violation of the General Regulations.
